For the devil:

Just as our society has prisons for lawbreakers, so God has a prison for those who live outside His laws. Jesus said Hell was "prepared for the devil and his angels." - Matthew 25:41

The devil is an malignant angel named Satan, who Jesus described as: "*a*

murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it." - John 8:44

FOR RELIGIOUS HYPOCRITES:

Jesus delivered a scathing sermon in the Temple aimed at religious hypocrites, whose hatred of truth and malicious attitudes marked them as being, "of your father, the devil." - John 8:44

"Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like white-washed graves! Outwardly you appear righteous to men, but within you are full of hypocrisy and iniquity! You serpents! You generation of vipers! How can you escape the damnation of Hell!" - Matthew 23

FOR THOSE WHO REJECT THE TRUTH:

Jesus told an actual account of a rich man who died and went to Hell. In Hell, he called out to Abraham to send Lazarus (a beggar that had died and gone to Paradise) to his five living brothers to warn them. Abraham said, "*They have Moses* and the prophets (the Bible), let them hear them." The rich man responded, "No, father Abraham: but if one went to them from the dead, they will repent." Abraham answered, "If thy will not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead." - Luke 16:19-31
