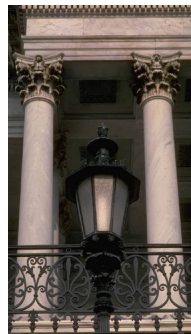

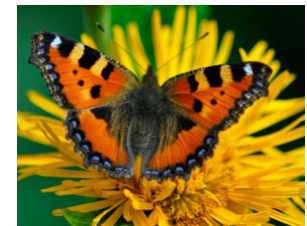

THE GIFT OF GOD



Set your mind on things above, not on things of the earth -
~ Colossians 3:2 ~

Salvation is a gift from God. It cannot be bought with money, earned by good works, or bestowed by a certain church, ritual or religious person. ***“It is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.”*** (Eph. 2:8,9)

What does God want to save you from? Sin and its consequences. Sin is lawlessness - doing what you know is wrong. Its consequences are death and hell.

This is the reason we all die. For ***“sin entered the world, and death through sin: and so death passed upon all people, for all have sinned.”*** (Romans 5:12)

God loves you so much, that His Son, Jesus, came to buy your ransom from death and hell. Your price? His own blood. Life for life. Through His death on the cross, He was ***“canceling the list of charges that were against us ... and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross.”*** (Colossians 2:14)

His resurrection is proof that the transaction that bought you out of death was “paid in full.”

Receiving the Gift:

So how do you receive the gift of eternal life? By receiving Christ! There are two prerequisites: ***“repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ.”*** (Acts 20:21)

Repentance is genuine sorrow toward God for the way we have treated Him by our life of sin.

Faith is putting your total confidence in *who* Jesus is (God, the Son), and what He has done to save you at the cross. ***“For there is no other name under Heaven, given among mankind, by which we must be saved.”*** (Acts 4:12)

New Life!

The moment you receive Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord (Owner of your life), God forgives every sin you have ever done, and sends His Holy Spirit into your life to begin an amazing ***“metamorphosis.”***

First, you will notice that you have a new hunger for God’s Word, the Bible. It is your spiritual food. Nothing else will

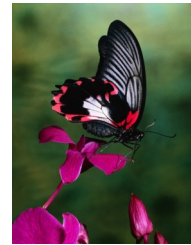
satisfy your heart as you get to know Jesus Christ through its pages.
