Have you ever wanted to see God?

In the book of Exodus in the Bible, Moses asked this very thing. Even though God talked with Moses often, it was always through a thick cloud. God said:

"You cannot see My face: for there shall no man see Me, and live. But look, there is a place by Me, and you shall stand upon a rock, and it shall happen that while My glory passes by, that I will put you in a cleft of the rock, and will cover you with My hand while I pass by. And I will take away My hand, and you shall see My back: but My face shall not be seen." – Exodus 33:20-23.

And the LORD passed by before Moses and proclaimed the name of the LORD, The LORD, the LORD God, merciful and gracious, long-suffering, and abounding in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and fourth generations." - Exodus 34:6,7

Moses wanted to see God but God wanted Moses to know His *name*. This is because God's name describes His character, the very essence of who He is. If we want to "see" God, we must look at what His name reveals.

The LORD: This name is literally written Yahweh, or Jehovah, and means: The One who was, is, and always shall be; The Ever-Existing One; the eternal I AM.

The LORD God: Jehovah Adonai - Adonai refers to the fact that as the Ever-Existing One, He is Lord and Master of heaven and earth.

Merciful: Compassionate treatment towards an offender or adversary.

Gracious: Showing kindness towards another (that would not show kindness to you).

Longsuffering: Slow to anger when wronged.

Abounding in Goodness: Pure in motive; having good intentions toward others.

Abounding in Truth: Factual, genuine, real.

Keeping mercy for thousands: This is God's guarantee that in spite of overwhelming wickedness in the world, He will deal with people on an individual basis. His loyal love will remain on the thousands that love and honor Him.

Forgiving iniquity, transgression and sin: Forgiveness means to take away guilt by carrying the load of another. Jehovah is a God who is longs to save sinners. So great is His love that He is willing to take upon Himself the penalty the law-

breaker deserves. No wonder the Bible declares there is no God like Jehovah!

Who will by no means clear the guilty: Having already declared His willingness to forgive sinners, those who spurn His forgiveness will most certainly have their day in court - and pay for their own guilt.

Visiting the iniquity of the father's upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and fourth generations: This verse is God's guarantee that those who *continue in sin*, will not go unpunished, no matter how much time goes by. God will hold accountable the unrepentant leaders of sin, (fathers) and their unrepentant followers (children) who perpetuate those sins. Time does not mean God has overlooked sin.

Be assured, God does *not* that punish innocent children because of their parents sins, as some falsely teach.

God Himself has said: "The soul that continues in sin, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him." - Ezekiel 18:20
